

How to Check Your Status Online:

Once you have activated your NetID and created a password at <https://tim.txstate.edu/onlinetoolkit/CustomLogin?ProceedIdVet=True>, you will be able to check your application status. Please follow the instructions below:

1. Go to https://ssb.txstate.edu/prod/twbkwbis.P_WWWLogin and enter your NetID and password.





4. Verify that your Name, Address and Application Data are correct. If any information is incorrect, please email us at gradcollege@txstate.edu.
5. Check items to see what is missing from your application. Below is an example of a program's requirements. Note: Anything without a received date has either not been received yet, has not been satisfied, or is still being processed by The Graduate College or university mailing offices.

Although most applications have admissions decisions made in approximately 4-6 weeks from the time they become "*Complete*", please check your program's web page for any specific decision processing time.
